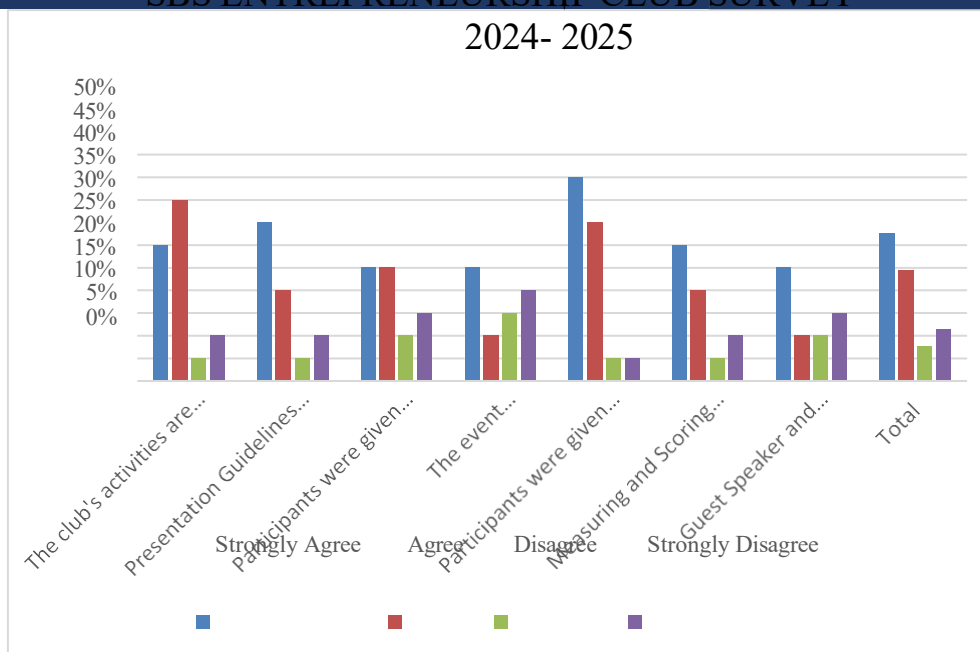
Although the positive feedback is resounding, the following are a few areas that could be improved to enhance the overall experience for participants and attendees in the next academic year.
